Local Emergency Management Director Training April 9-11, 2019

OBJECTIVE: The Kentucky Division of Emergency Management (KYEM) will provide to newly appointed and experienced local emergency management professionals a basic understanding of and updates on Emergency Management statutes and regulations, the operation of KYEM branches, and ancillary support programs available to aid local emergency management personnel.

Course Description: The primary focus of this course is to provide training to **new** County Emergency Management Directors and Assistant Directors within 12 months of appointment to their position. If the available number of seats in the course are not filled by new appointees, the remaining class seats may be filled by veteran County Emergency Directors, Deputy Directors, other emergency management staff and volunteers. All students should have completed the online IS-700, IS-800, IS-100, and IS-200 courses prior to attending this training. Copies of course completion certificates must be provided no later than the first day of class to the training POC listed below.

Students will receive training and education on the basic principles needed to operate their local emergency management office and will leave the training with a comprehensive, basic understanding of the Emergency Management organization at the local, state, and federal levels.

The course begins ***promptly on Day 1*** at 9:00 A.M (Eastern) and ***concludes on Day 3*** at 3:30 P.M. (Eastern). Course hours vary daily and a course outline will be emailed to accepted participants. Students should wear comfortable, business casual clothing. There are no outdoor activities associated with this course. Students should bring paper, pens, and pencils for use during the course.

Special Notes: The course minimum is 20 pre-registered students with a maximum number of 40 students for the course. **Each participant will be responsible for all expenses associated with meals, lodging, and travel to and from the training site.**
