1. Purpose of the System

The Community Hazard Assessment & Mitigation Planning System (CHAMPS) is a tool used by local, regional, and state managers, planners, and responders to build community resiliency through a streamlined and standardized process for planning, assessments, and funding of projects. CHAMPS is truly a community focused tool that uses information from public and private sectors to build a Community Profile. The Community Profile gives a snapshot of the community's infrastructure, planning efforts, funding opportunities, and preparations for disaster recovery. This combined picture helps a community determine how resilient it is and what its needs are for improvement.

CHAMPS consists of five modules: Community Profile, Assessments, Plans, Funding, and Projects. Each of these modules feeds the goal of Community Resiliency - a community's ability to respond to and recover from any natural or man-made disaster.

2. Who can use this system?

Any local, regional or state manager, planner, administrator, or elected official will benefit from CHAMPS. CHAMPS is already being used to catalog thousands of pieces of community infrastructure, local agency (both government and volunteer) information, and FEMA funded Hazard Mitigation Projects. This information gives local officials and first responders a view of important infrastructure and community organizations that can respond in a disaster.

3. Interactivity with other KYEM Systems

Use of CHAMPS is based on five roles: viewer, author, local administrator, manager, and system administrator. CHAMPS pulls these roles and all organizational contact information from KYEM's ITEAMS system. CHAMPS also interacts with KYEM's mapping system (KAATS), allowing infrastructure, projects, plans, assessments, etc. to be viewed in relationship to each other on a map.
