KAMM invites you to go on a leisurely walk or a hike as a preconference event on Monday, September 17. Join us at 4:30 to begin the walk. Bring your hiking boots!

Lake Barkley State Resort Park Trails

Begin the hike with us along the **Lena Madessin Phillips Interpretive Trail** that is 0.75 mile. This trailhead is located below the lodge's playground that leads to a looped trail and numbered stations that correlate with a trail booklet. This hike has scenic views of the lake and a swinging bridge.

You can stop your hike after the Lena Madessin Phillips Interpretive Trail or continue with us for a longer hike to the following two optional trails:

- The **Cedar Grove Trail** is a 2 miles linear trail with the outlet located near the beach parking lot
- The **Wilderness Trail** is a 2.4-mile linear trail with the outlet that lies just north of the stables. At trail's end, cross the paved road and re-enter the woods near water tower.
